The Ohangwena Regional Council, Works Maintenance and Technical Services Sub-Division reserves the right:

2. Preparation of Quotations

The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of bid submission deadline.

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the **Ohangwena Regional Council**, Works Maintenance and Technical Services Sub-Division, with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

3. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Works Maintenance and Technical Services Sub-Division not later than 23 May 2024 at 10H00. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Ohangwena Regional Council, Works Maintenance and Technical Services Sub-Division by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

4. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Works Maintenance and Technical Services Sub-Division PMU staffs immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. At a bid opening, the name of the bidder, the total amount of each bid, any discount or alternative offered, and the presence or absence of any Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration if required and the document referred to in Section 50(2) are read out and recorded and a copy will be available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

5. Evaluation of Quotations

Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.
