# SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The Ohangwena Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) To split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) To accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) To cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

### 2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration (a)
- (b) The List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- The Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and (c)

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

### 3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

### 7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to Ohangwena Regional Council with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

### 8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be hand delivered to in a bid box at the Reception area of Ohangwena Regional Council, not later than the 23 December 2024 at 10:00. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by Fax or e-mail will not be considered.

### 9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Ohangwena Regional Councils immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration, will be available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

#### **10. Evaluation of Quotations**

The **Ohangwena Regional Council** shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are **substantially responsive** shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the **lowest evaluated quotation**.

#### **11. Technical Compliance**

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to **Ohangwena Regional Council** requirements.
