General Terms and Conditions Applicable

1. Employer

The Public Entity inviting the Informal Quotation is the Employer for the purpose of entering into contract with the successful bidder.

2. Service Provider

The bidder having submitted the lowest price and whose offer is substantially responsive to the requirements specified shall be selected for award and referred to as the Service Provider.

3. Rights of Public Entity

The Public Entity shall have the rights to

- (a) ask for clarifications at time of evaluating quotations and
- (b) reject all quotations.

A Public Entity shall not be bound to accept the lowest or any quotation.

4. Eligibility Criteria

The bidder or supplier must submit the following documents at the time of submitting a bid to a public entity, failing which the bidder or supplier must disqualified:

- (a) a valid certificate of good standing with the Receiver of Revenue;
- (b) a valid certificate of good standing with the Social Security Commission or, in the case where a company has no employees, confirmation letter from the Social Security Commission; (c) As required by the Affirmative Action (Employment) Act, 1998 (Act No. 29 of 1998) –
- (i) a valid affirmative action compliance certificate issued under section 41 of that Act;
- (ii) an exemption issued under section 42 of that Act; or
- (iii) a proof from the Employment Equity Commissioner that the bidder or supplier is not a relevant employer as defined in that Act;
- (d) a written undertaking as contemplated in section 138 (2) of the Labour Act, 2007 (Act No. 11 of 2007); and
- (e) a valid:
- (i) certificate of business registration for an entity incorporated or registered under the company or close corporation laws of Namibia;
- (ii) certificate of registration of a co-operative registered under the laws regulating co-operative in Namibia;
- (iii) document serving as evidence of registration as a trust and the trust deed for a trust registered under the laws regulating trusts in Namibia; or
- (iv) partnership agreement in the case of a partnership, valid joint venture agreement in the case of a joint venture or a valid agreement in case of the similar arrangements, BUT a bidder or supplier who is a sole proprietor only needs to comply with the provisions of paragraph (a) to (d).

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation, a Bid Securing Declaration as per the format contained in Schedule 1 of this document

6. Validity of the quotation

The quotation should be valid for **60 days** from the due date of the submitting quotations.

7. Prices

Prices shall be quoted in Namibian dollars. Prices quoted shall be firm and fixed during validity period of quotation and for execution of contract.

8. The Contract

The letter of Acceptance/Purchaser Order Form as the case may be together with this Informal Quotation form shall constitute the contract between the Public Entity and the Service Provider

9. Purchase Order

A service provider to whom a purchase order is issued must confirm the purchase order within three days of receipt of the purchase order and;

- (a) May not change or alter the terms of the purchase order; and
- (b) must undertake to deliver the services on or before the date set in the purchase order for delivery of the services.
- (c) the purchase order shall be valid for 30 days only and will be cancelled thereafter.

10. General Conditions of Contract N/A

The general terms and conditions shall be as per the General Conditions of Contract (Services).

11. Project Manager

The Project Manager is the person appointed by the Employer responsible for supervising the execution of the services and administrating the contract.

12. Advanced payment

Advance payment is not applicable.

13. Payment

The Employer undertakes to effect payment within 30 days after completion of the services to the satisfaction of the Client subject to the Service Provider making goods all defects and submitting all required documents to initiate payment. Final payment shall be adjusted to reflect any noncompliance in the execution of the contract.
